SUMMER STUDY ABROAD PROGRAM

This program offers students a diversity of lens through which to understand The Emerald Isle. Using an experiential model of learning, the program will explore Dublin as well as the countryside and coasts of Ireland (including Galway) so that the very nation itself becomes the "text." Students will delve into the country's social and educational systems, history, literature, and music all while taking in the sights and sounds of Irish cultural life. Conversations with professionals from P-12 schools will allow students to explore Ireland's educational system and how it supports diverse and multicultural learning needs. To complement field experiences, students will study the various historical and contemporary literary representations of "the fighting Irish" and immigrant underdogs to help them better understand the historical experience of immigration from Ireland to America. Let Ireland be your context for an intellectually rich and eye-opening cultural experience this summer!
