SUMMER STUDY ABROAD PROGRAM

This program emphasizes the impact of culture on the educational and psychosocial needs of diverse children. This course is designed to: 1) develop counselor sensitivity, awareness, and training in human diversity; 2) introduce multicultural theory in concepts, competencies, and research; and 3) provide an experiential component for application of multicultural and global awareness. Costa Rica is well-known for its biodiversity, as well as for the rich cultural diversity of its people. While abroad, students will engage in experiential learning in local schools and communities. Participants will have the opportunity to interact with students and educators in the capital city of San José, as well as in the remote Osa Peninsula.
