SUMMER STUDY ABROAD PROGRAM

Spain and Portugal are two of Europe's most appealing destinations for students looking for a cultural immersion rich in history, food, sport, and scenery. The program will begin in Portugal, exploring its Atlantic-influenced cuisine and multiple sport organizations. From there, students will move to Spain for the majority of this program to learn about the rich culture of one of the largest Western European countries. Program courses will examine nutritional and organizational characteristics of each country and learn how research is communicated and performed in different cultures. Interaction with local faculty and students will expose students to health and sport professions in Spain and Portugal and allow for students and faculty to connect course content to each country's environment.
