Financing your education abroad does not have to be confusing. Please use this reference guide as you work to fund your program.

AM I ELIGIBLE FOR FINANCIAL AID TO PAY FOR MY EDUCATION ABROAD?

Financial Aid is comprised of the scholarships, grants, and loans that you qualify for based on need and/or merit. Many aid opportunities require that you submit a completed FAFSA each year between October 1st and March 15th for the following year abroad program. As a general rule, **students are eligible for two semesters** of financial aid eligibility per academic year (i.e. Fall, Spring, and the following Summer term). That means if you spend a semester co-oping, interning, or otherwise off campus, you may be eligible to use a semester of UD aid in the Summer. Additional funding may be available via the Federal Parent PLUS loan or private loans. **Please meet with a Financial Aid Counselor to discuss your options, today!**
